An ace-high straight flush, commonly known as a royal flush, is the best possible hand in many variants of poker.

In poker, players form sets of five playing cards, called hands, according to the rules of the game.[1] Each hand has a rank, which is compared against the ranks of other hands participating in the showdown to decide who wins the pot.[2] In high games, like Texas hold 'em and seven-card stud, the highest-ranking hands win. In low games, like razz, the lowest-ranking hands win. In high-low split games, both the highest-ranking and lowest-ranking hands win, though different rules are used to rank the high and low hands.[3][4]

Each hand belongs to a category determined by the patterns formed by its cards. A hand in a higher-ranking category always ranks higher than a hand in a lower-ranking category. A hand is ranked within its category using the ranks of its cards. Individual cards are ranked, from highest to lowest: A, K, Q, J, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3 and 2.[5] However, aces have the highest rank under ace-to-five high or six-to-ace low rules, or under high rules as part of a five-high straight or straight flush.[6][7] Suits are not ranked, so hands that differ by suit alone are of equal rank.[8]

There are nine categories of hand when using a standard 52-card deck, except under ace-to-five low rules where straights, flushes and straight flushes are not recognized. An additional category, five of a kind, exists when using one or more wild cards. The fewer hands a category contains, the higher its rank.[9] There are  $52! / (52 - 5)! = 311,875,200$  ways to deal five cards from the deck but only  $52! / (52 - 5)! / 5! = 2,598,960$  distinct hands, because the order in which cards are dealt or arranged in a hand does not matter.[10] Moreover, since hands differing only by suit are of equal rank, there are only 7,462 distinct hand ranks.[11]

Five of a kind [ edit ]

Five of a kind, aces

Five of a kind is a hand that contains five cards of one rank, such as 3 3 3 3 3 ("five of a kind, threes"). It ranks above a straight flush but is only possible when using one or more wild cards, as there are only four cards of each rank in the deck.[6] Five of a kind, aces, A A A A Jkr, becomes possible when a joker is added to the deck as a bug, a form of wild card that may act as a fifth ace.[5] Other wild card rules allow jokers or other designated cards to represent any card in the deck, making it possible to form five of a kind of any rank.[12]

Each five

of a kind is ranked by the rank of its quintuplet. For example, Q Q Q Q Q ranks higher than 6 6 6 6 6.[6][13]

Straight flush [ edit ]

A jack-high straight flush

A

straight flush is a hand that contains five cards of sequential rank, all of the same suit, such as Q J 10 9 8 (a "queen-high straight flush").[4] It ranks below five of a kind and above four of a kind.[5] Under high rules, an ace can rank either high (as in A K Q J 10, an ace-high straight flush) or low (as in 5 4 3 2 A, a five-high straight flush), but cannot simultaneously rank both high and low (so Q K A 2 3 is an ace-high flush, but not a straight).[6][13] Under deuce-to-seven low rules, an ace always ranks high (so 5 4 3 2 A is an ace-high flush). Under ace-to-six low rules, an ace always ranks low (so A K Q J 10 is a king-high flush).[14] Under ace-to-five low rules, straight flushes are not possible (so 9 8 7 6 5 is a nine-high hand).[7]

Each straight flush is ranked by the rank of its

highest-ranking card. For example, 10 9 8 7 6 ranks higher than 8 7 6 5 4, which ranks higher than 6 5 4 3 2. Straight flush hands that differ by suit alone, such as 7 6 5 4 3 and 7 6 5 4 3, are of equal rank.[6][13]

An ace-high

straight flush, such as A K Q J 10, is called a royal flush or royal straight flush and is the best possible hand in ace-high games when wild cards are not used.[5][15][16] A five-high straight flush, such as 5 4 3 2 A, is called a steel wheel and is both the best low hand and usually the best high hand of the showdown in ace-to-five high-low split games.[4]

Four of a kind [ edit ]

Four of a kind, fives

Four

of a kind, also known as quads, is a hand that contains four cards of one rank and one card of another rank (the kicker), such as 9 9 9 9 J ("four of a kind, nines"). It ranks below a straight flush and above a full house.[5]

Each four of a kind is ranked

first by the rank of its quadruplet, and then by the rank of its kicker. For example, K K K K 3 ranks higher than 7 7 7 7 Q, which ranks higher than 7 7 7 7

10. Four of a kind hands that differ by suit alone, such as 4 4 4 4 9 and 4 4 4 4 9, are of equal rank.[6][13]

Full house [ edit ]

A full house, sixes over

kings

A full house, also known as a full boat or a tight or a boat (and originally

called a full hand), is a hand that contains three cards of one rank and two cards of another rank, such as 3 3 3 6 6 (a "full house, threes over sixes" or "threes full of sixes" or "threes full").<sup>[17][18]</sup> It ranks below four of a kind and above a flush.<sup>[5]</sup>

Each full house is ranked first by the rank of its triplet, and then by the rank of its pair. For example, 8 8 8 7 7 ranks higher than 4 4 4 9 9, which ranks higher than 4 4 4 5 5. Full house hands that differ by suit alone, such as K K K J J and K K K J J, are of equal rank.<sup>[6][13]</sup>

Flush [ edit ]

A jack-high flush

A flush is a hand that contains five cards all of the same suit, not all of sequential rank, such as K 10 7 6 4 (a "king-high flush" or a "king-ten-high flush").<sup>[19]</sup> It ranks below a full house and above a straight.<sup>[5]</sup> Under ace-to-five low rules, flushes are not possible (so J 8 4 3 2 is a jack-high hand).<sup>[7]</sup>

Each flush

is ranked first by the rank of its highest-ranking card, then by the rank of its second highest-ranking card, then by the rank of its third highest-ranking card, then by the rank of its fourth highest-ranking card, and finally by the rank of its lowest-ranking card. For example, K J 9 6 4 ranks higher than Q J 7 6 5, which ranks higher than J 10 9 4 2, which ranks higher than J 10 8 6 3, which ranks higher than J 10 8 4 3, which ranks higher than J 10 8 4 2. Flush hands that differ by suit alone, such as 10 8 7 6 5 and 10 8 7 6 5, are of equal rank.<sup>[6][13]</sup>

Straight [ edit ]

A ten-high straight

A straight is a hand that contains five cards of sequential rank, not all of the same suit, such as 7 6 5 4 3 (a "seven-high straight"). It ranks below a flush and above three of a kind.<sup>[5]</sup> Under high rules, an ace can rank either high (as in A K Q J 10, an ace-high straight) or low (as in 5 4 3 2 A, a five-high straight), but cannot simultaneously rank both high and low (so Q K A 2 3 is an ace-high hand).<sup>[6][13]</sup> Under deuce-to-seven low rules, an ace always ranks high (so 5 4 3 2 A is an ace-high hand). Under ace-to-six low rules, an ace always ranks low (so A K Q J 10 is a king-high hand).<sup>[14]</sup> Under ace-to-five low rules, straights are not possible (so 10 9 8 7 6 is a ten-high hand).<sup>[7]</sup>

Each straight is ranked by the rank of its highest-ranking card. For example, J 10 9 8 7 ranks higher than 10 9 8 7 6, which ranks higher than 6 5 4 3 2. Straight hands that differ by suit alone, such as 9 8 7 6 5 and 9 8 7 6 5, are of equal rank.<sup>[6][13]</sup>

An ace-high straight, such as A K Q J 10, is called a Broadway straight,<sup>[20]</sup> while a five-high straight, such as 5 4 3 2 A, is called a baby straight,<sup>[21]</sup> bicycle or wheel and is the best possible hand in ace-to-five low games (where it is a high card hand, not a straight).<sup>[22][23]</sup>

Three of a kind [ edit ]

Three of a kind, queens

Three of a kind, also known as trips or a set, is a hand that contains three cards of one rank and two cards of two other ranks (the kickers), such as 2 2 2 K 6 ("three of a kind, twos" or "trip twos" or a "set of twos"). It ranks below a straight and above two pair.<sup>[5]</sup>

Each three of a kind is ranked first by the rank of its triplet, then by the rank of its highest-ranking kicker, and finally by the

rank of its lowest-ranking kicker. For example, 6 6 6 Q 4 ranks higher than 3 3 3 K 2, which ranks higher than 3 3 3 J 7, which ranks higher than 3 3 3 J 5. Three of a kind hands that differ by suit alone, such as 9 9 9 10 8 and 9 9 9 10 8, are of equal rank.[6][13]

In community card games, such as Texas hold 'em, three of a kind is called a set only when it comprises a pocket pair and a third card on the board.[24]

Two pair [ edit ]

Two pair, jacks and threes

Two pair is a hand that contains two cards of one rank, two cards of another rank and one card of a third rank (the kicker), such as J J 4 4 9 ("two pair, jacks and fours" or "two pair, jacks over fours" or "jacks up").[17][25] It ranks below three of a kind and above one pair.[5]

Each two pair is ranked first by the rank of its higher-ranking pair, then by the rank of its lower-ranking pair, and finally by the rank of its kicker. For example, 10 10 2 2 K ranks higher than 5 5 4 4 10, which ranks higher than 5 5 3 3 Q, which ranks higher than 5 5 3 3 J. Two pair hands that differ by suit alone, such as K K 7 7 8 and K K 7 7 8, are of equal rank.[6][13]

One pair [ edit ]

One pair, tens

One pair, or simply a pair, is a hand that contains two cards of one rank and three cards of three other ranks (the kickers), such as 4 4 K 10 5 ("one pair, fours" or a "pair of fours"). It ranks below two pair and above high card.[5]

Each one pair is ranked first by the rank of its pair, then by the rank of its highest-ranking kicker, then by the rank of its second highest-ranking kicker, and finally by the rank of its lowest-ranking kicker. For example, 9 9 Q J 5 ranks higher than 6 6 K 7 4, which ranks higher than 6 6 Q J 2, which ranks higher than 6 6 Q 8 7, which ranks higher than 6 6 Q 8 3. One-pair hands that differ by suit alone, such as 8 8 10 6 5 and 8 8 10 6 5, are of equal rank.[6][13]

High card [ edit ]

High card, king

High card, also known as no pair or

simply nothing, is a hand that does not fall into any other category, such as K J 8 7 4 ("high card, king" or "king-jack-high" or "king-high").[17][26] Note that under ace-to-five low rules, straights, flushes and straight flushes are not possible, so such hands are instead high card hands.[7] It ranks below one pair.[5]

Each high card

hand is ranked first by the rank of its highest-ranking card, then by the rank of its second highest-ranking card, then by the rank of its third highest-ranking card, then by the rank of its fourth highest-ranking card, and finally by the rank of its lowest-ranking card. For example, K 6 5 3 2 ranks higher than Q J 6 5 3, which ranks higher than Q 10 8 7 4, which ranks higher than Q 10 7 6 4, which ranks higher than Q 10 7 5 4, which ranks higher than Q 10 7 5 2. High card hands that differ by suit alone, such as 10 8 7 6 4 and 10 8 7 6 4, are of equal rank.[6][13]

Under deuce-to-seven low rules, a seven-five-high hand, such as 7 5 4 3 2, is the best possible hand.[27] Under ace-to-six low rules, where aces have the lowest rank, a six-four-high hand, such as 6 4 3 2 A, is the best possible hand.[28] Under ace-to-five low rules, where aces have the lowest rank and straights,

flushes and straight flushes are not possible, a five-high hand, such as 5 4 3 2 A or 5 4 3 2 A, commonly known as a bicycle or wheel, is the best possible hand.[7][22]

### 1. Encuentra tu demográfico

La competencia es dura, por lo que encontrar el lugar adecuado para vender tu ropa te dará la mejor oportunidad de ponerlos frente a las personas que podrían desear comprarlos.

"Depop tiende a atraer más a la generación Z, por lo que no se adapta bien a las piezas que estoy vendiendo, mientras que Vinted tiene un rango amplio de compradores de todas las edades", dice Becky Barnes, estilista sostenible. "Uno de mis lugares más exitosos para vender zapatos y ropa es el grupo de Facebook de la comunidad local. Como vendedor, es más fácil porque no tienes que empaquetar y enviar cosas - las personas suelen querer recoger."

### 2. Proporciona {img}s claras

Si muestras un artículo en un colgador o publicas {img}s de ti usando la prenda, intente obtener una selección de {img}s claras desde diferentes ángulos, con primeros planos del tejido y incluya una toma del rótulo y las instrucciones de cuidado.

Tómelos con iluminación que los muestre como realmente son - Natacha Blanchard de Vinted recomienda colocar la ropa contra un fondo blanco para que su contorno sea claro.

Kirsty Keoghan, gerente general global de moda en eBay, dice que los vendedores que venden artículos en el sitio pueden usar su herramienta de eliminación de fondo para crear una imagen más atractiva y su herramienta de creación de listados alimentada por IA para ayudar con las descripciones.

### 3. Se descriptivo y honesto

Use más palabras clave de las que piensa que necesita: esto ayudará a los compradores a encontrar sus artículos cuando busquen.

Blanchard dice: "A veces, el color no aparece en la {img} como en la vida real, por lo que siempre preste atención a eso". Si no es posible tomar {img}s con buena iluminación que muestre los colores verdaderos, señalará en la descripción que el tono es más claro o más oscuro de lo que parece.

Siempre sea claro sobre el tamaño, también. Si algo resulta más pequeño o más grande de lo que esperarías, menciónalo. "Incluye tus medidas básicas - altura, busto, cintura y caderas - para que la gente pueda decir inmediatamente si algo le quedará", dice Barnes. "Toma un poco más de tiempo, pero vale la pena sacar la cinta métrica y agregar esas medidas clave para que la gente entienda lo que está comprando."

Si hay defectos, arañazos o enganches, menciónelos en tu publicación e incluya {img}s de esas partes. "Siempre trato de pensar en la venta como si fuera a comprar: ¿qué necesitaría saber sobre un artículo, ¿qué información necesitaría ver?" dice Blanchard.

### 4. Consigue el timing correcto

Piensa estacionalmente. "En este momento del año, estaría pensando en vender vestidos de verano y cosas que combinen con la temporada. En octubre serían abrigos y ropa más cálida", dice Blanchard.

Si ha tenido una limpieza y realmente desea deshacerse de las cosas rápidamente, estar preparado para bajar los precios o puede encontrar difícil vender.

La hora de tu publicación también cuenta. Retenerse y publicar cuando los compradores navegan activamente puede garantizar que tu listado aparezca alto en la página y reciba más visitas.

"Sabemos que más personas enumeran en sábados, y la gente tiene una tendencia a comprar en domingos y días festivos", dice Blanchard.

### 5. Alimenta de manera drip tu stock

Después de una poda de armario, puede ser tentador poner todo en línea de inmediato. En su lugar, es sabio publicar unas pocas cosas cada día.

Katie Rowe, que vende ropa en Depop, dice: "Publico todos los días para ser lo más consistente posible para maximizar mi exposición."

Barnes está de acuerdo: "Si tuviera 10 artículos, no subiría todo a la misma plataforma. Agregaría dos o tres al día, todos los días, solo para tratar de mantenerme en la parte superior del algoritmo."

### 6. BR paquetes y descuentos

En sitios como Vinted y Depop, puedes elegir ofrecer un descuento a las personas que compren varios artículos de ti.

Tú eliges el porcentaje que te gustaría quitar cuando configures tu cuenta. Es atractivo para el comprador porque, además del descuento, pagarán menos por el envío.

"A veces hago ofertas de paquetes a través de la aplicación Depop, lo que significa que si un comprador compra dos o más artículos, pueden obtener un porcentaje del precio final", dice

Amber Ramon, vendedora regular en Depop.

## 7. Se amigable en las negociaciones

La venta en línea a menudo requiere interacción con los compradores.

"Vinted, y otras plataformas, se trata de individuos, y si enumeras en Vinted, debes estar listo para interactuar. Los compradores potenciales pueden tener muchas preguntas", dice Blanchard. "Prepárese para las negociaciones: la gente tratará de comprar por menos. Es parte del proceso."

## 8. Empaca y envía bien

Empaqueta los artículos cuidadosamente y asegúrate de que estén protegidos. "Algunas personas les gusta ser creativos con su embalaje", dice Blanchard. "Eso puede ir desde empaquetar con mucho cuidado hasta incluir una nota amable cuando envíe artículos. Todo el mundo tiene su propio enfoque."

Cualquiera que sea el suyo, sea oportuno con el empaque y el envío. Si tiene clientes felices, pueden regresar a su página. Pero tal vez, más importante aún, darán una opinión positiva, lo que tranquilizará a los compradores subsiguientes de que puede confiar en usted.

## 9. Compruebe las tarifas de venta

Listar artículos a menudo es gratuito en plataformas de segunda mano: eBay eliminó recientemente las tarifas para los vendedores particulares de ropa usada (vendedores y compradores deben estar en el Reino Unido) y muchas plataformas cobran a los compradores, en lugar de a los vendedores.

Por ejemplo, los compradores pagan una "tarifa de protección de comprador" del 3% al 8% del precio antes del envío en cada compra de Vinted, además de entre 30p y 80p.

Depop tiene una tarifa de mercado del alrededor del 5% más £1, que también se carga a los compradores. Aunque no tiene una tarifa de vendedor por así decirlo, hay una tarifa de procesamiento para los pagos, el servicio a través del cual se reciben los pagos. Los vendedores pagan el 2,9% del precio de venta (incluido el costo de envío) más 30p.

## 10. Compruebe los requisitos fiscales

La mayoría de las personas no tendrán que pagar impuestos sobre los artículos que venden en línea. Sin embargo, desde enero de este año, HM Revenue and Customs ha requerido que los mercados en línea y otras "plataformas digitales" recopilen y reporten información sobre cuánto dinero ganan sus usuarios.

Los sitios web en países que han firmado las reglas establecidas por la Organización para la Cooperación y el Desarrollo Económicos deben recopilar datos sobre los vendedores del Reino Unido y compartirlos con HMRC.

Los expertos en impuestos y sitios como MoneySavingExpert.com dicen que las plataformas solo informarán automáticamente a HMRC si alguien vende 30 o más artículos al año, o gana más de la equivalente a €2,000 al año de esta actividad (un poco menos de £1,700 en el momento de escribir).

Además, todos tienen un allowance de trading cada año fiscal, lo que significa que pueden ganar hasta £1,000 sin pagar impuestos.

HMRC tiene una herramienta que le permite verificar si tiene algo que hacer.
